Most Wanted! There are some Most Wanted posters hanging on the vestibule bulletin board. We should organize several posses and locate the Most Wanted!

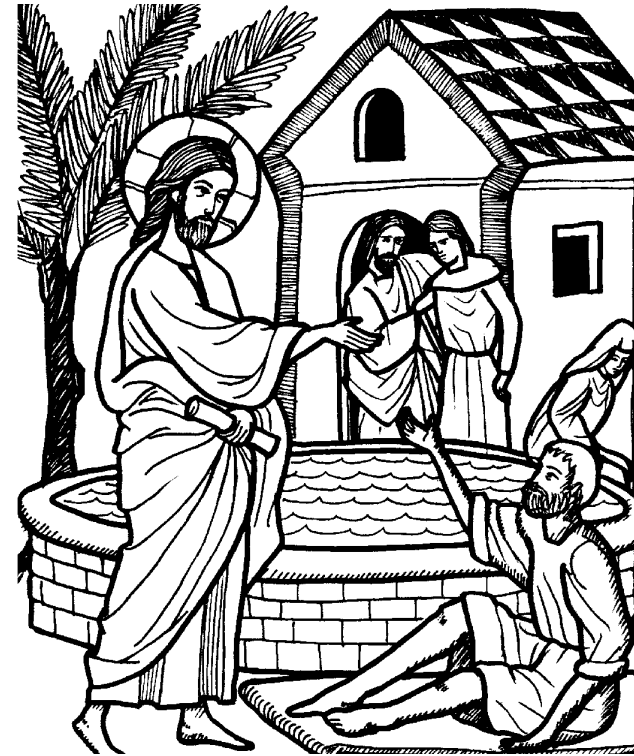

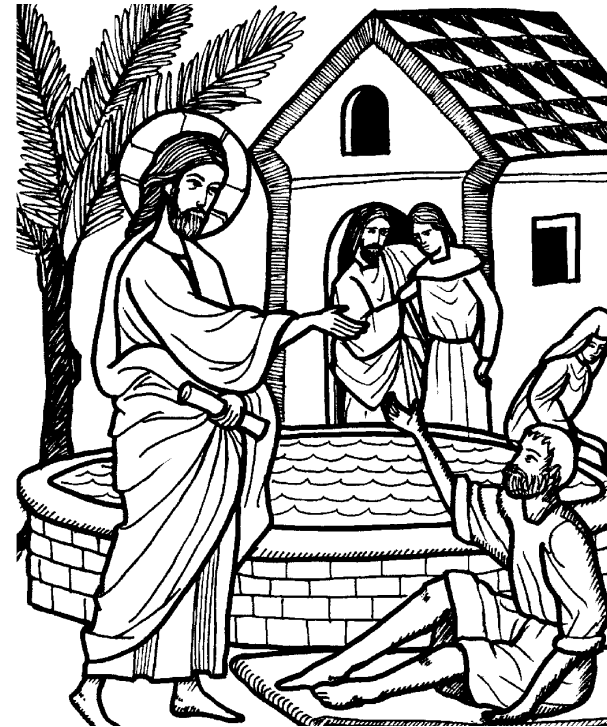
