Attendance should help to stimulate parish interest. The Parish Forum is continuing its program of offering grants to attending parishes for beginning new ministries or strengthening existing ministries. In 2018 four parishes received grants. To be eligible your parish must attend and submit a written grant application. Grant requests will be accepted up to a maximum of \$2,000.
