Holy Martyr Nicetas

Nicetas was a Goth born near the Danube River who converted to Christ in his youth. The Gothic kingdom was divided and at war, and in 370 King Athanaric of the eastern kingdom began to persecute the Christians in his region. Nicetas was one of those seized. He was beaten and thrown alive into the fire. He sang hymns from the midst of the flames until he perished. Though nominally Arian (as were all the Goths after 376), he no doubt held this belief through ignorance, not understanding the philosophical subtleties of the Arians but loving Christ our God in simplicity of heart. He died for his Lord as a true martyr in about 378.
